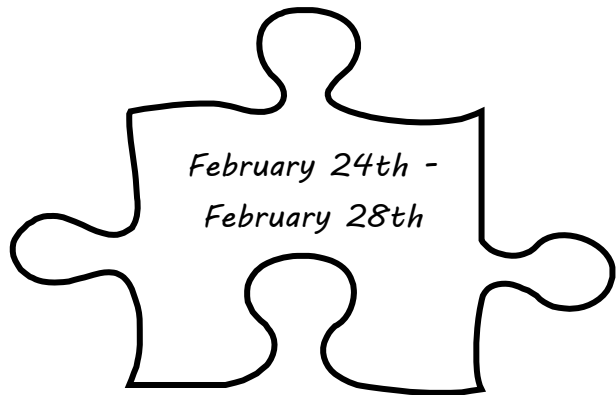


Miss Koldon's Class Newsletter

A Note From Our Speech Therapist:

Question: Will using flashcards promote language development?

Answer: No. Learning a new word from a flashcard teaches a child to say a word in response to a picture. This does not mean that the child truly understands the meaning of the word. New vocabulary is learned during meaningful interactions in everyday life. Children learn best through playful interactions with people who love them.
