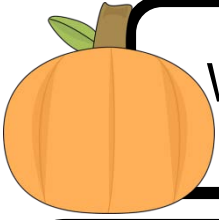


# September/October

Week of September 30-October 4

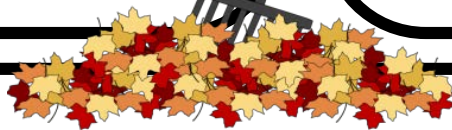

## Speech Tip from Miss Grace:

With Fall arriving, it is a great time to go for a walk! When on the walk, point to different things you see like trees, leaves, and birds. Use the word, "Look!" to help a child understand that they should look at something. When your child points to something, model the word out loud. Pointing and modeling words on a walk helps increase vocabulary. It is also a great way to spend time together as a family.
